

Explanatory Note

To

By-law No. 2025-51

The purpose of this By-law would allow the Town to proceed with the Installation of one (1) new stop sign in the north bound direction of Sandy Lane at Eastdale Drive/Sandy Lane, creating a one-way controlled stop, and

One (1) new stop sign in the north bound direction on Albert Street at the Coastline Drive/Coastline Drive intersection, creating a one-way controlled stop.

Eastdale Drive and Coastline Drive are both one-way roadways where motorists travel from west to east. There are currently no existing stop signs in the locations noted above and the Town is implementing new controlled stops to provide safer entry/exit onto these roadways and reduce right-of-way conflict.

This By-law is properly before Council for consideration.

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF WASAGA BEACH

BY-LAW NO. 2025-51

A By-law to amend By-law No. 81-04, as amended, being a By-law to designate Through Streets (Sandy Lane and Albert Street).

WHEREAS pursuant to *The Highway Traffic Act*, the Council of the local municipality is Authorized to designate the location of yield and stop signs within a municipality;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to those Regulations, the Council of the Town of Wasaga Beach passed By-Law No. 81-04 on the 27th day of January 1981;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Wasaga Beach deems it necessary to amend the said By-law specifically as it relates to new stop sign locations for new subdivisions and/or to improve traffic control at existing intersections;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF WASAGA BEACH HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Schedule "A" to By-law No. 81-04, be amended, by adding stop signs at the following location:
 - a) Sandy Lane, northbound at Eastdale Drive, creating a "One-Way Stop" condition.
 - b) Albert Street, northbound at Coastline Drive, creating a "One-Way Stop" condition.
2. That all other sections of By-law No. 81-04, as amended, shall apply and remain in effect.
3. That this By-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of its final passing.

BY-LAW READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 23RD DAY OF OCTOBER 2025.
